### King Jesus

Read the passage below and answer questions 1 – 14.

In the beginning God created Adam and Eve. They sinned. God made a way out when He promised salvation to mankind in the Garden of Eden. He said, "I will put enmity between you and the woman and between your seed and her seed. He shall bruise you on the head." (Genesis 2:7 – 23, Genesis 3:1 – 15)


Jesus was born circa 6 BC in Bethlehem in fulfillment of God's plan and the prophecy of Isaiah approximately 860 years earlier. His mother, Mary, who was a virgin, was betrothed to Joseph, a carpenter. Christians believe that Jesus was born through Immaculate Conception.

His lineage can be traced back to the House of David. According to Matthew, Jesus was born during the reign of Herod the Great, who felt threatened and ordered all of Bethlehem's male children, under 2 years of age, be killed. Joseph fled to Egypt. He later came and settled in Nazareth. (Matthew 1:2 – 2:21)

At the age of 12, Jesus accompanied His parents to the Passover Festival in Jerusalem and became separated. He was found several days later in the temple sitting among the teachers, listening and asking questions. Everyone was amazed at His understanding and His answers! (Luke 2:42 – 47)
